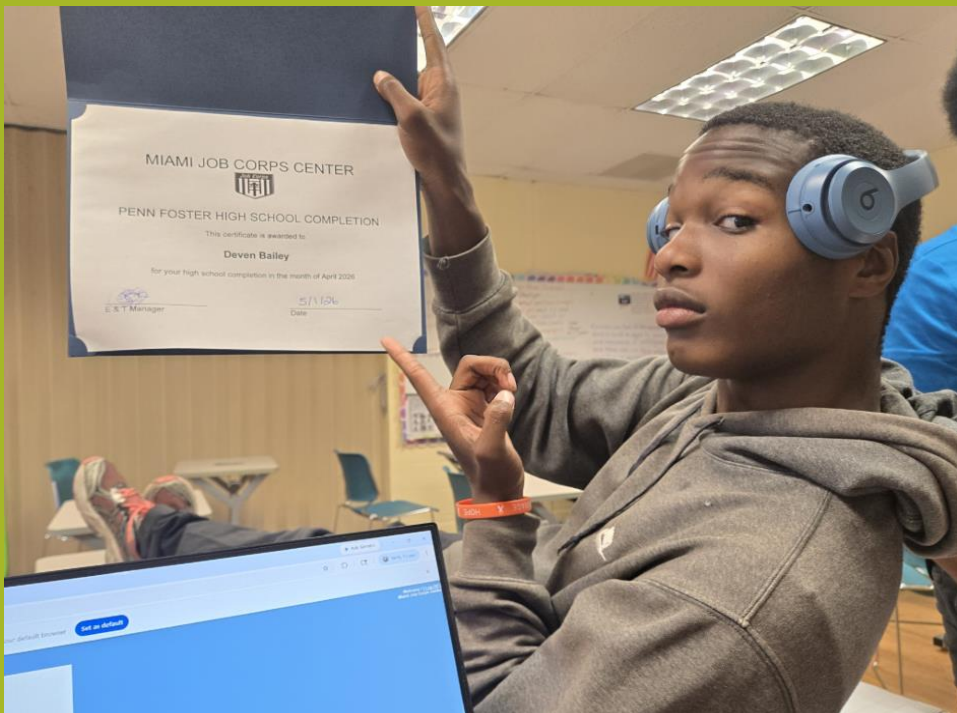

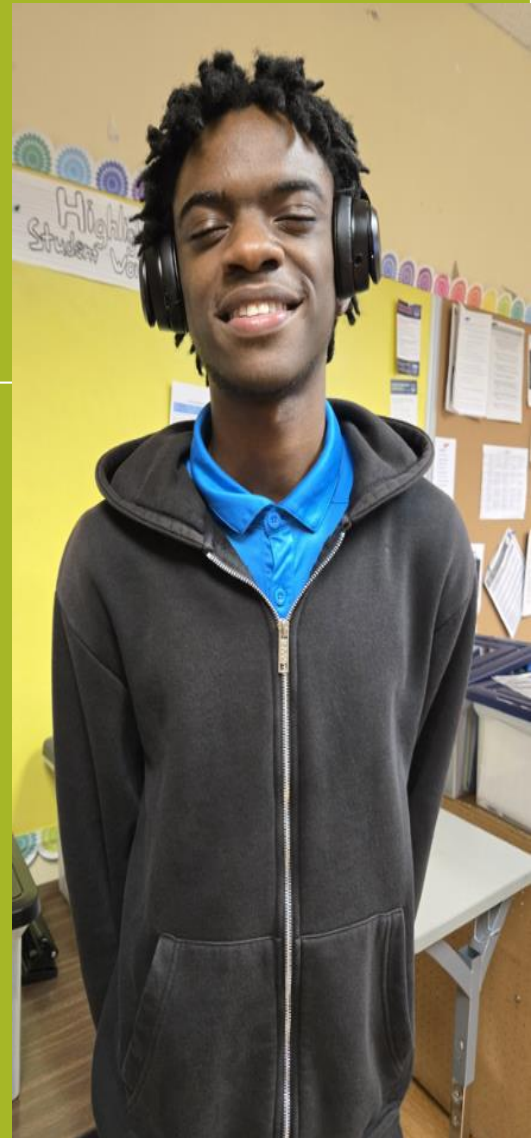
### A Smart Choice for the Future

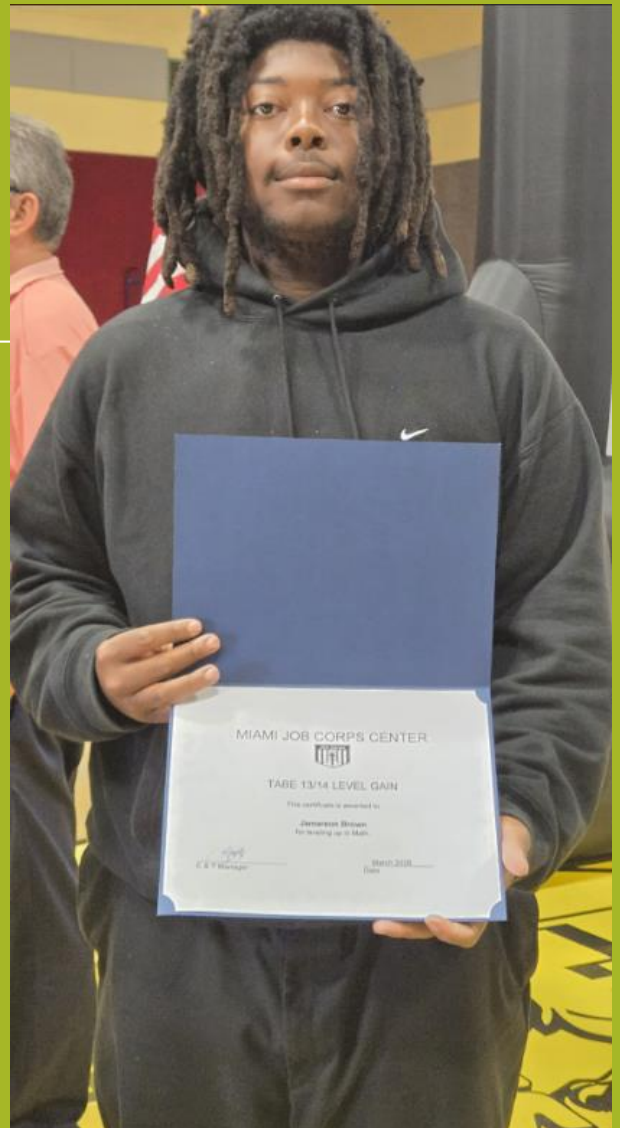



**What is a  
sexual assault  
response team?**



- 1 — Sexual Assault Response Team**  
A multidisciplinary team of professionals who work together to establish best practices and create streamlined protocols for working with survivors of sexual assault.
- 2 — Multidisciplinary Team**  
A SART is team of professionals from law enforcement, prosecutors, medical personnel/sexual assault nurse examiners, child advocacy centers, domestic/sexual violence agencies, victim advocates, etc.
- 3 — Goals**  
Create trauma-informed protocols, improve communication between agencies, and increase education/awareness for sexual assault.
- 4 — Trauma-Informed Care**  
One of the key focus areas for a SART is trauma-informed care, which is an approach that demonstrates an understanding of the effects of trauma on an individual.

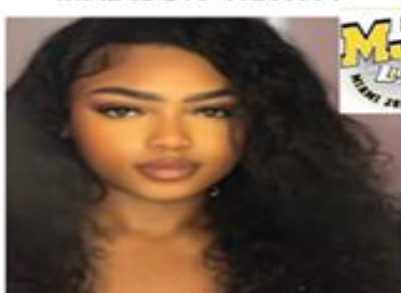
