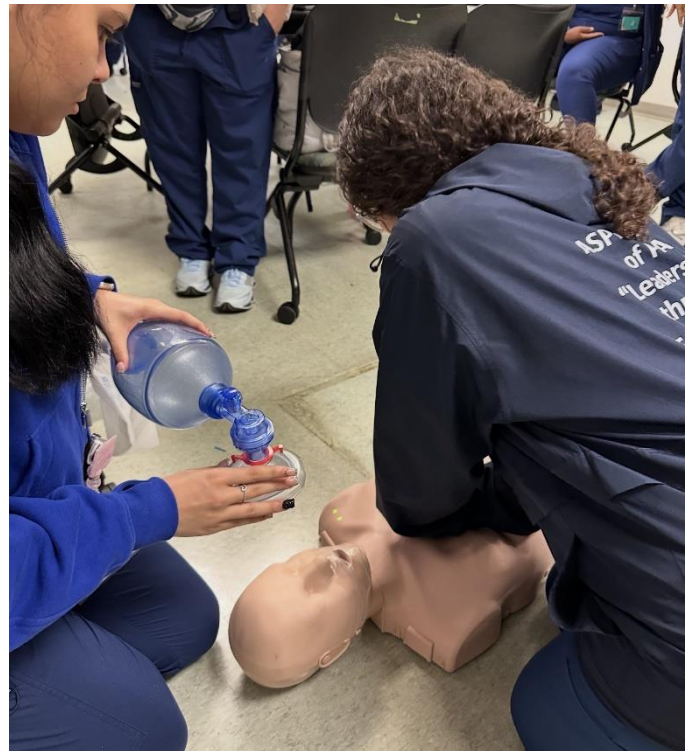
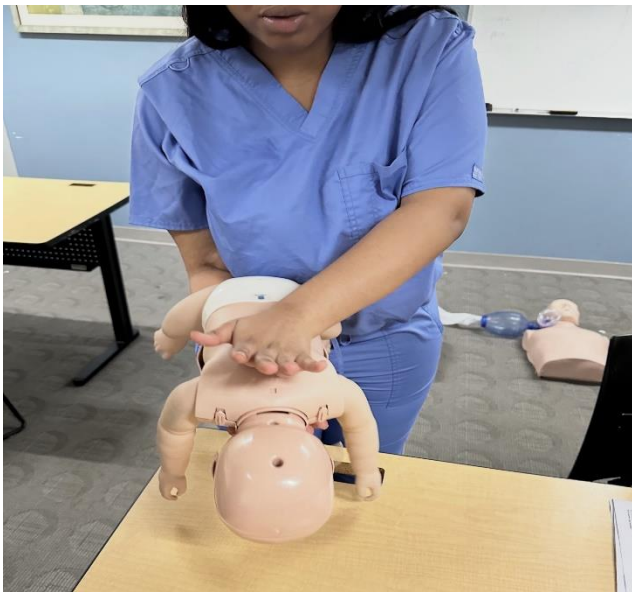

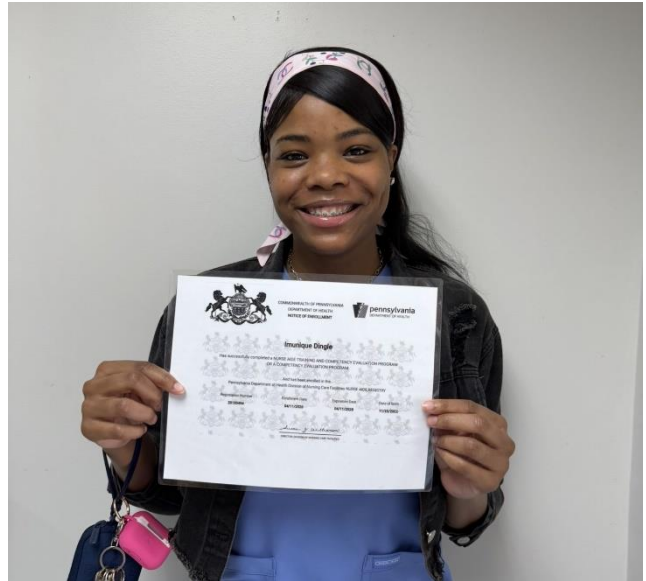
## LEARNING TO SAVE LIVES

# CTT CORNER

Under the guidance of experienced instructors, students learn how to properly draw blood, handle laboratory equipment, and follow important safety and infection control procedures. The practical training allows students to build confidence while developing the technical skills needed to succeed in healthcare careers.

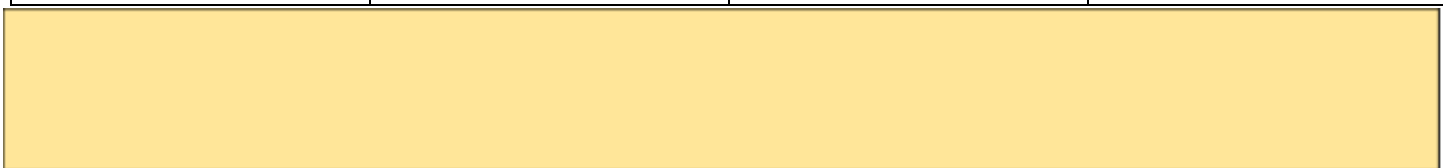
