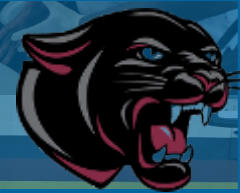

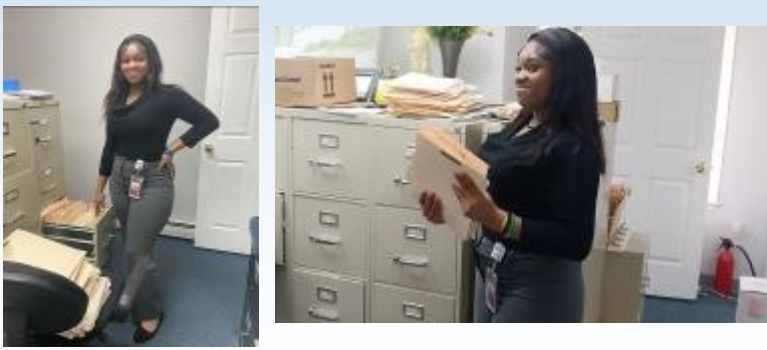
American Red Cross & GJCC

Fieldtrip of the week!

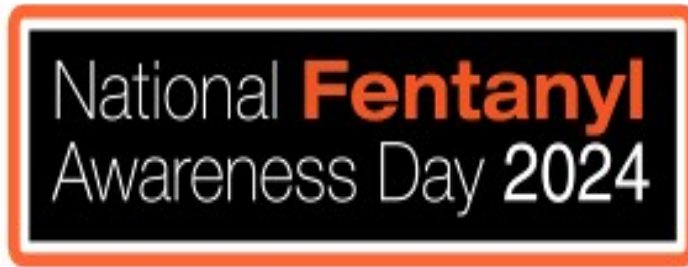



<p>Shortcuts are executed when specific buttons on the keyboard are pressed at the same time. For example..</p> <p>I love my cats!</p>  <p>When you press Ctrl + C together, you will copy anything that is highlighted or selected to your clipboard.</p>	<p>When something is on the clipboard, we use Ctrl + V to paste the copy.</p> 	<p>Alternatively, you can use Ctrl + X instead of Ctrl + C to Cut.</p> <p>I love my cats!</p>  <p>This will remove the what is selected instead of making a copy.</p>
<p>Another useful pair of shortcuts is Ctrl + Z to Undo an action.</p>  <p>And Ctrl + Y to Redo an action.</p>	<p>Ctrl + A will highlight everything on a page.</p>  <p>Ctrl + F will help you find text on a page.</p>	<p>Alt + Tab will switch the application that you are using. Alt + F4 will force close the application that you currently have open.</p>  <p>Windows + Tab will display all opened applications. Windows + L will lock your computer so no one can access it while you are away from the keyboard.</p>

Funded by Congress, Job Corps has been training young adults for meaningful careers since 1964. Job Corps is committed to offering all students a safe, drug-free environment where they can take advantage of the resources provided. Job Corps' mission is to attract eligible young people, teach them the skills they need to become employable and independent, and place them in meaningful jobs or further education.
